Position Title: Part-Time Reports to: Music Director 15 hours per week/ semi-flexible schedule Rector/Priest

Position Summary

Church of the Messiah is seeking a talented and collaborative **Music Director** to lead and enrich the musical life of our parish. This 15-hour-per-week position combines performance, leadership, and creativity to support the worship and spiritual life of our community. The Music Director will work closely with the priest, staff, and volunteers to plan and offer music that inspires and uplifts.

Primary Responsibilities

Worship Leadership & Organ Performance

- Select and prepare a wide range of service music in collaboration with the priest.
- Lead and support congregational singing with skill and pastoral sensitivity.
- Play the **organ and piano** for all Sunday services and special liturgical occasions (Christmas, Holy Week, Easter, etc.)

(Playing for weddings and funerals is generally expected, and compensated separately.)

Director of Adult Choir

- Direct the Adult Choir, including weekly rehearsals and Sunday anthems.
- Prepare music aligned with the liturgical calendar and choir capabilities.
- Foster a spirit of joy, inclusion, and excellence in choral leadership.

Director of Bell Choir

- Lead and rehearse the **Bell Choir** on a regular basis.
- Schedule performances throughout the church year, integrating them into worship.

Develop and Direct Youth Choir

- Create and nurture a Youth Choir program.
- Recruit and engage children and youth in music-making and worship leadership.
- Plan regular rehearsals and occasional services involving youth.

Liturgical Collaboration

- Work closely with the **priest** to plan services that reflect the seasons and themes of the liturgical year.
- Attend staff and liturgy planning meetings.
- Share musical expertise to enhance the church's mission and worship experience.

Administration

- Maintain a music library, care for instruments, and manage choir resources
- Communicate with staff and volunteers about rehearsal schedules and service music.
- Coordinate substitutes and manage the music ministry budget as needed.

Qualifications

- Degree in music or equivalent professional experience
- Proficient in organ and piano performance
- Experienced choral conductor, especially with adult choirs.
- Comfortable directing **bell choirs** and developing a **youth music program**.
- Familiarity with liturgical worship traditions (Episcopal/Anglican preferred).
- Strong organizational and communication skills.
