Janine is a lifelong member of Christ Church Bellport. She is the mother of three young adults, a grandmother and currently works with students with disabilities, neurodivergent and Autism. She is a faithful servant for her love of Native American ministry work and to advocate for continued acknowledgment and presence of Native American ministry in the Episcopal and Anglican Churches.
